- 2. Tom has 54 toys and decided to share them evenly between himself and his 2 brothers. How many toys did they each get?
- 3. Jerry started a company and earned \$1200 in his first month, \$400 in his second month and \$600 in his third month. How much did he earn over those 3 months?
- 4. Simon wanted to bake 24 cupcakes. He had 3 trays which fit them all in perfectly. How many cupcakes could each tray hold?

- 2. Tom has 54 toys and decided to share them evenly between himself and his 2 brothers. How many toys did they each get? They each got 18 toys.
- 3. Jerry started a company and earned \$1200 in his first month, \$400 in his second month and \$600 in his third month. How much did he earn over those 3 months? He earned \$2,200.
- 4. Simon wanted to bake 24 cupcakes. He had 3 trays which fit them all in perfectly. How many cupcakes could each tray hold?
 Each tray could hold 8 cupcakes.
